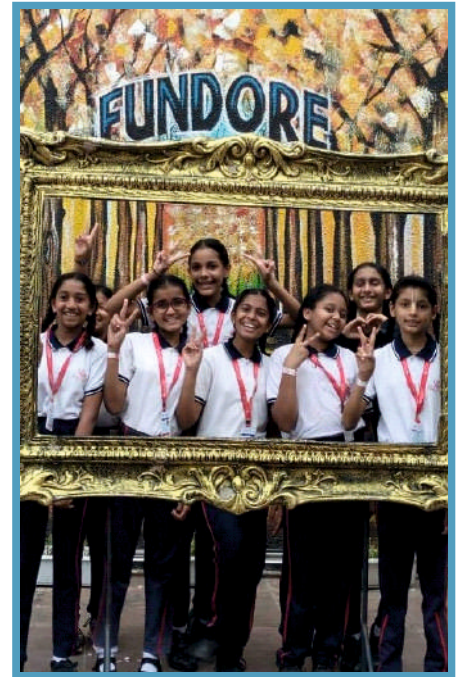
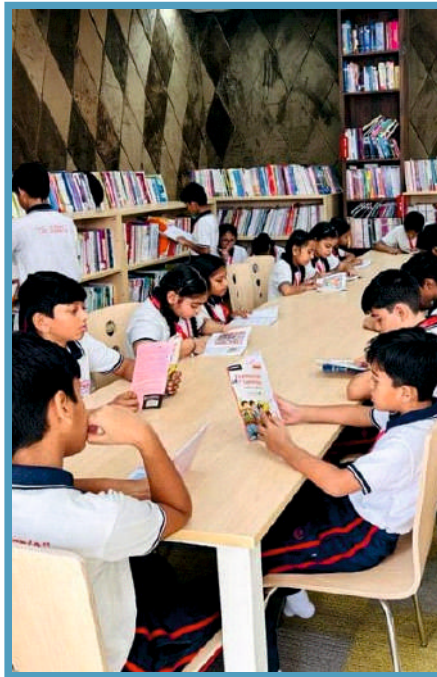


The Jubilance: The Feeling of Joy was a great success, as joy was seen among the children by competing with each other and coming out as great winners!!

Achievements of our students are the indicators of heights they can scale in future.

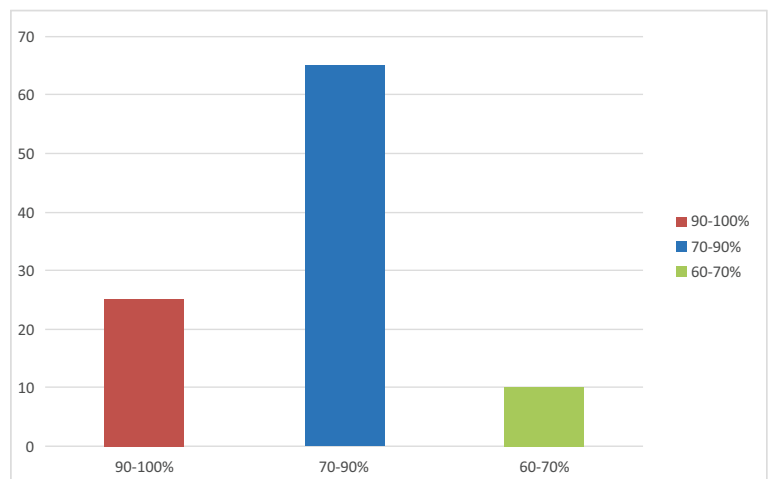
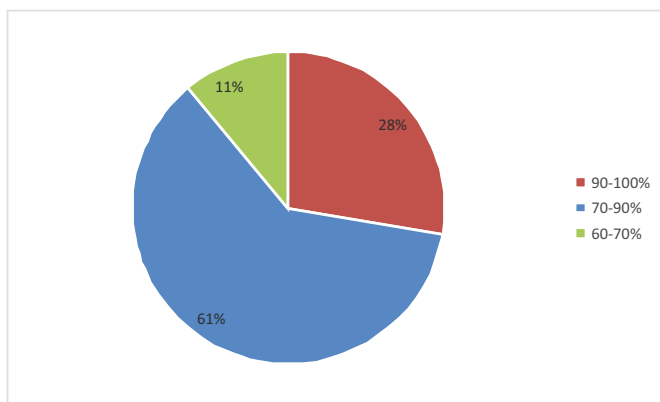
Total 79 students appeared in the CBSE board examination, out of which 9 students scored above 90% and 30 students scored above 80%.

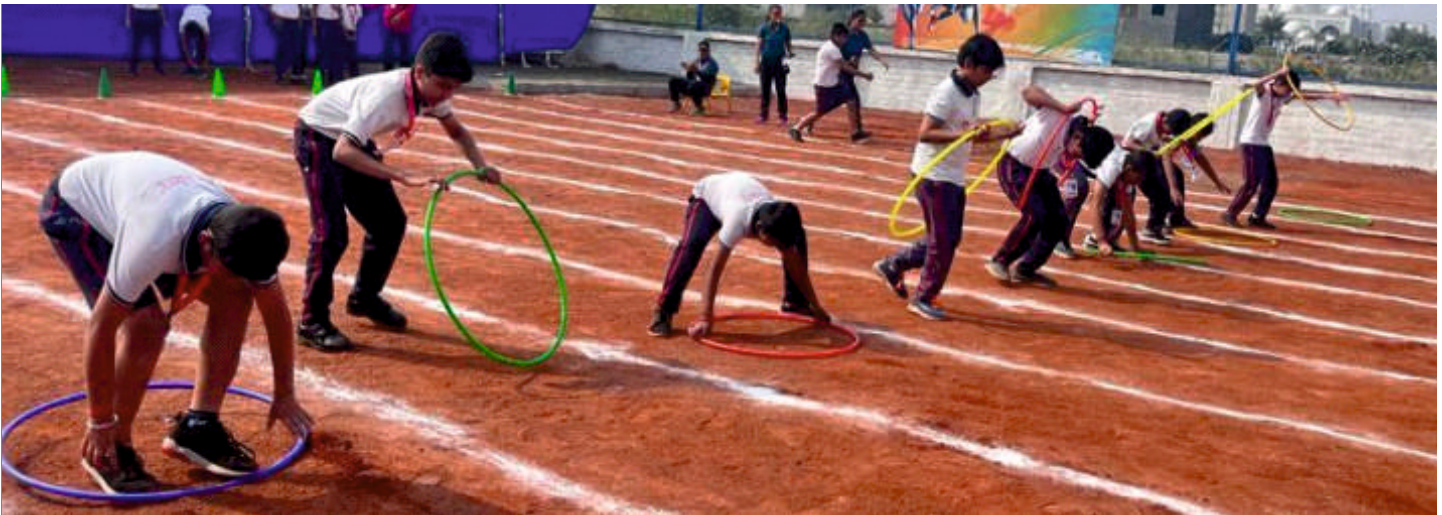
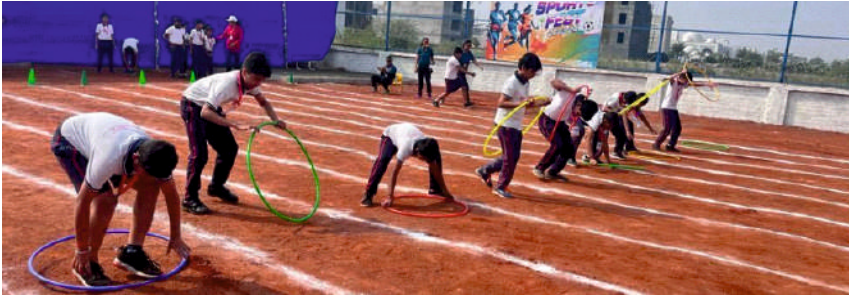
















Winning Waves: Riding the Success of Sports Carnival

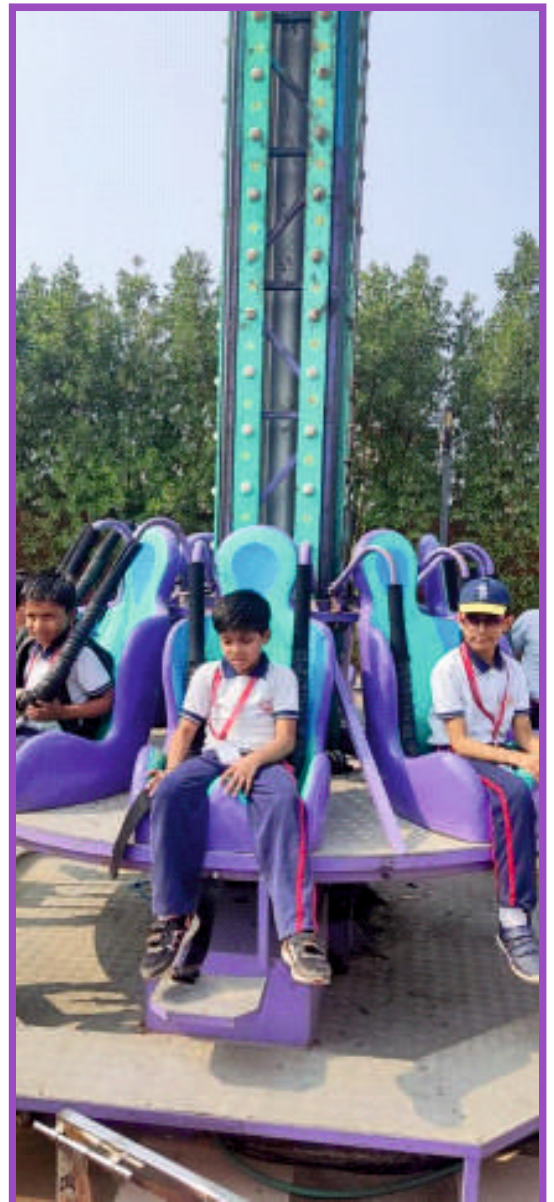
UNLEASHING THE SPIRIT OF ADVENTURE

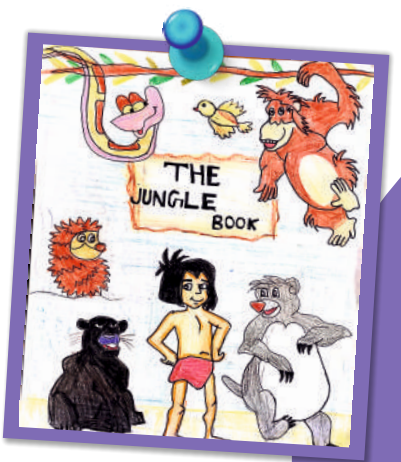
Story - Magical Snowman

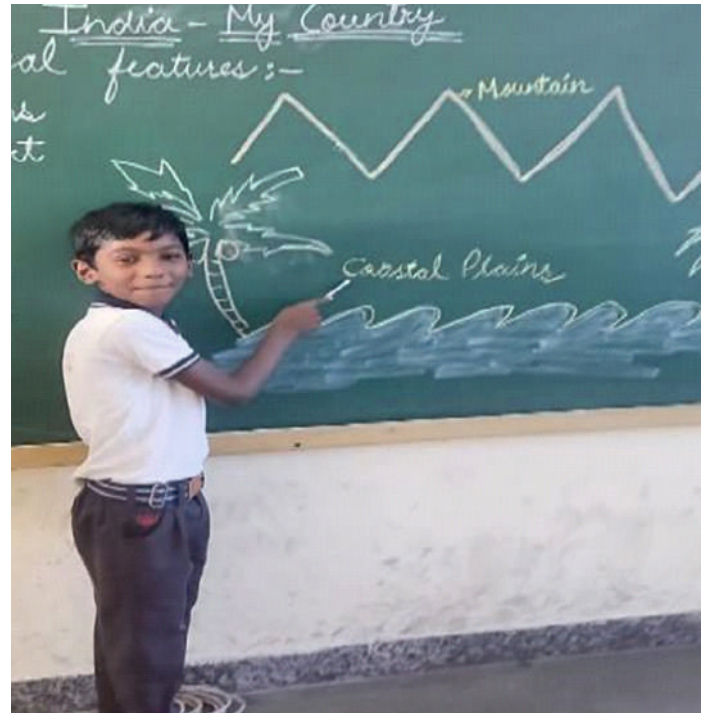
TRAVELOUGUE

Learning about prime and composite numbers help students to develop number sense. They learn to identify and categorize numbers based on their factors, which enhances their overall Mathematics skills.

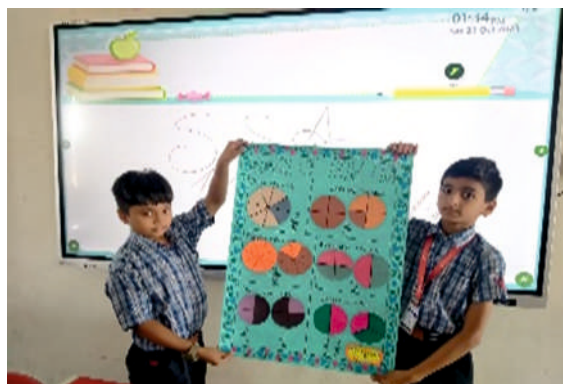


MAGICAL FRACTION BIRD

FIRST AID KIT

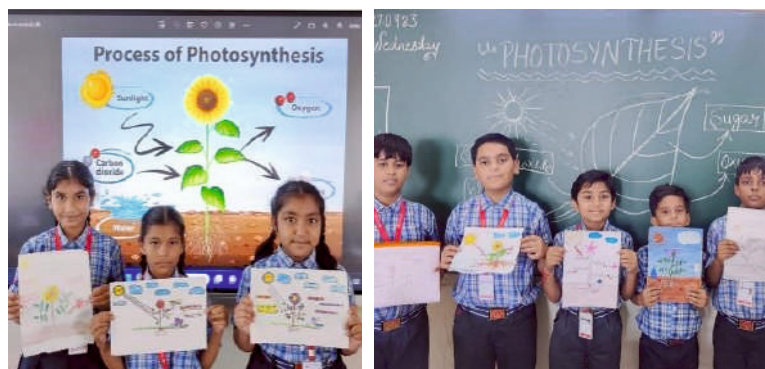

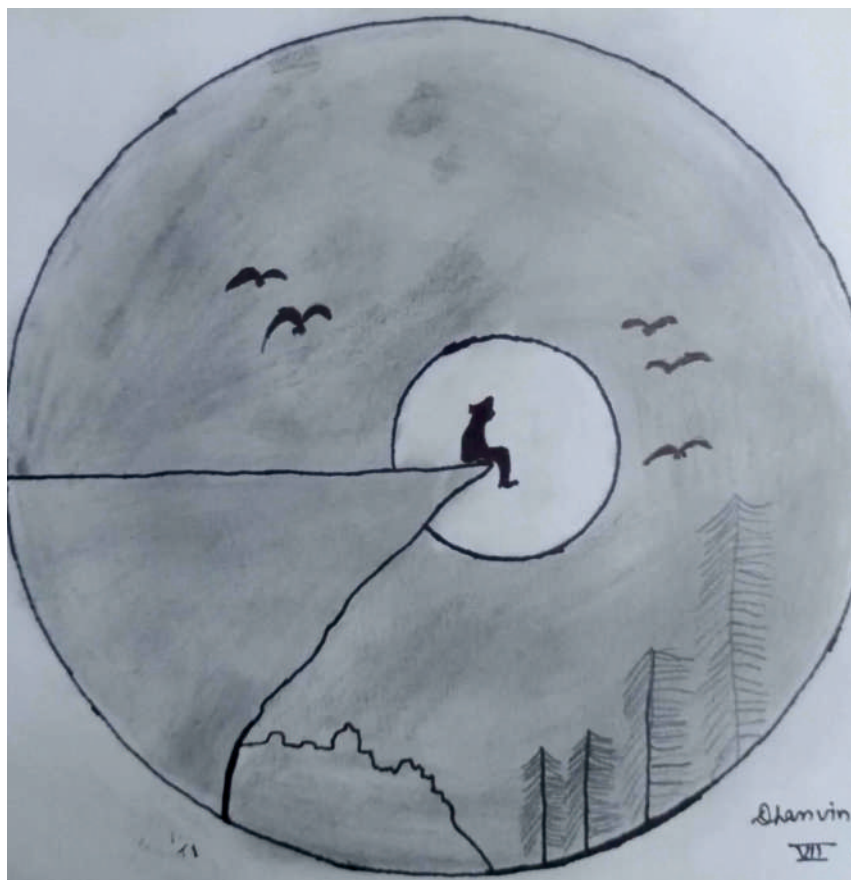
HOW CAN RECYCLING BENEFIT US?

The school experience is often more than just acquiring academic knowledge. While participating in new extra-curricular activities can be daunting, it is useful to remember that the primary role of a student is to learn.

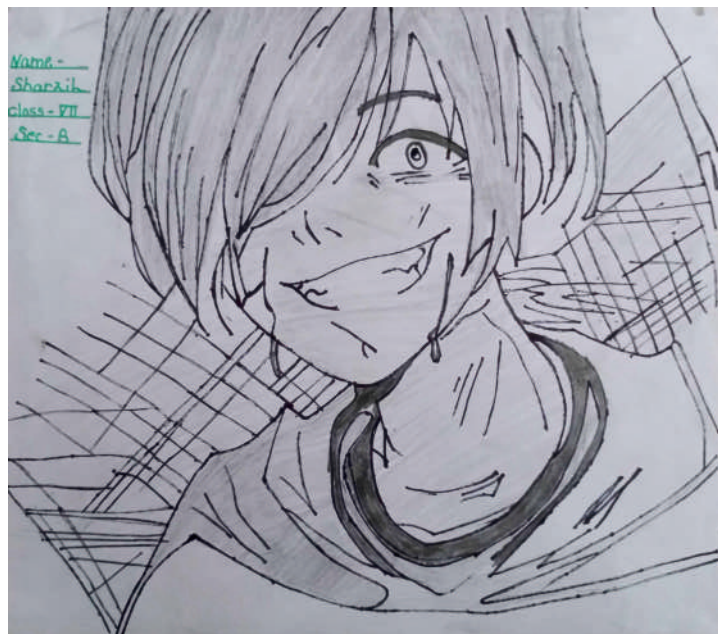

Regularity is important not only for academic excellence but also for learning discipline, caring and sharing. School life is where one makes friends for a lifetime.

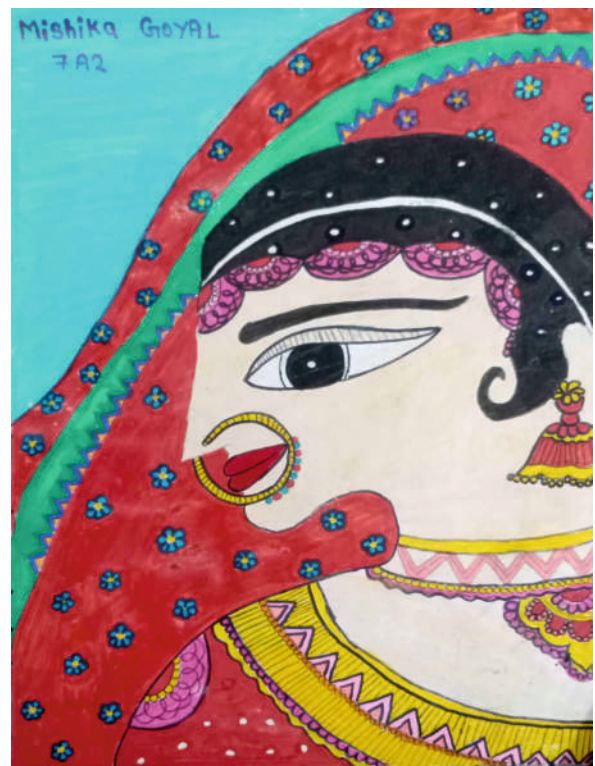

LIQUID HYDROGEN FUEL

Researchers are developing a hydrogen-based car fuel system with zero greenhouse emissions, using a liquid converted by a catalyst. This system utilizes a unique liquid that, when combined with the solid catalyst, transforms into hydrogen fuel for a car. After usage, the spent liquid is removed from the vehicle's tank and recharged with hydrogen making it ready for reuse. This process forms a closed-loop system that significantly reduces environmental impact.

PLASMA

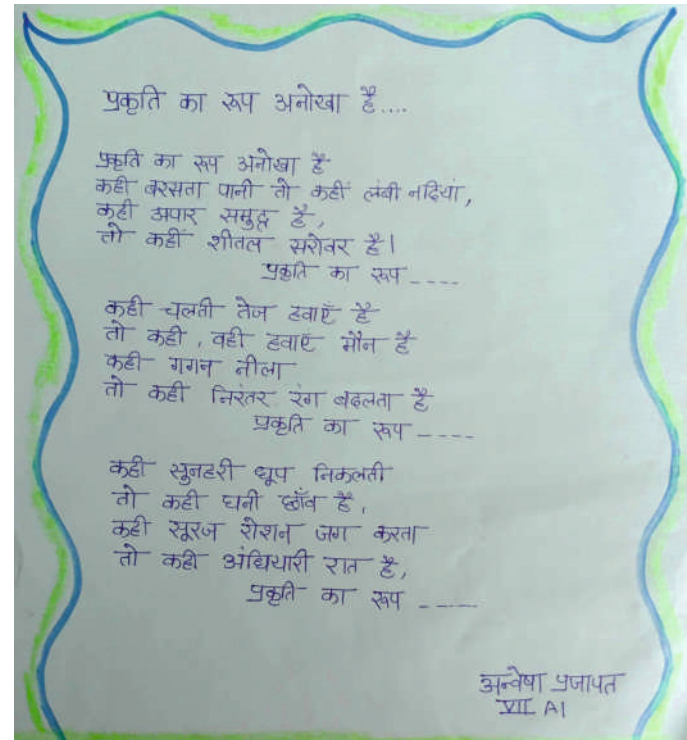
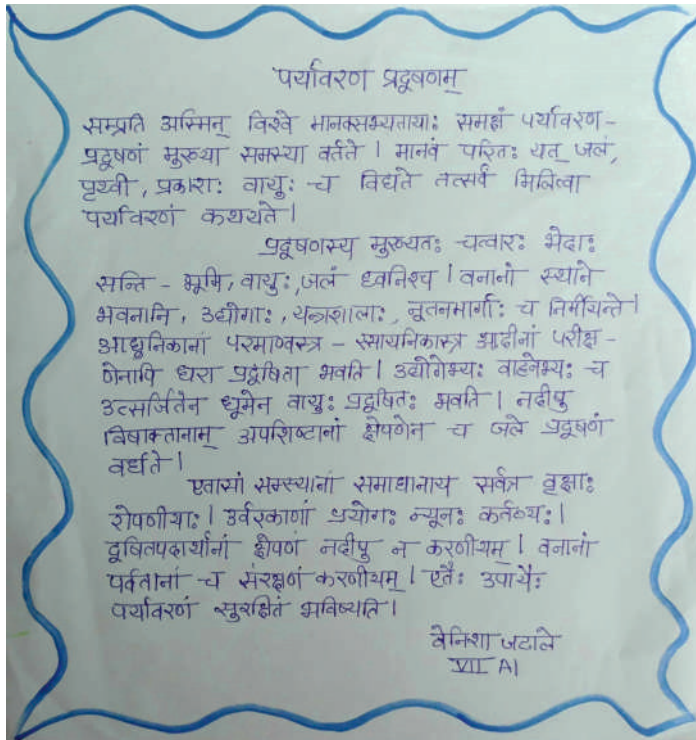
Plasma is often called "the fourth state of matter" along with solid, liquid and gas. Just as a liquid will boil, changing into a gas when energy is added, heating a gas will form a plasma – a soup of positively charged particles (cations) and negatively charged particles.

Plasma is an ionized gas consisting of approximately equal number of positively and negatively charged particles. For example: fire.

Fire is a plasma, not a gas or a solid. It's a kind of transient state between being composed of the elements before ignition and spent fumes. (smoke – solid particles and gases)

Recently I went through two incidents giving me the reality check regarding use of speech recognition AI devices in our day to day house hold life.

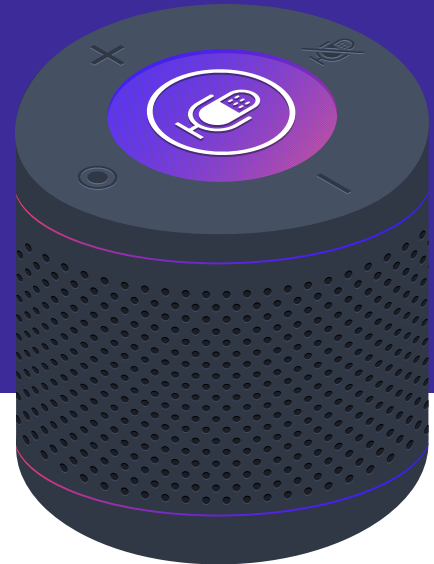
