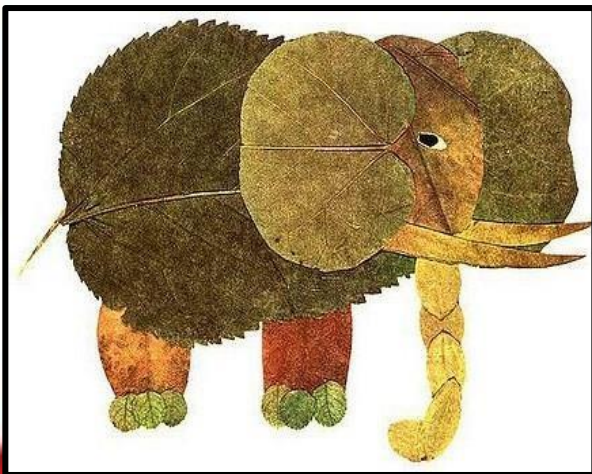
Leaf Art
